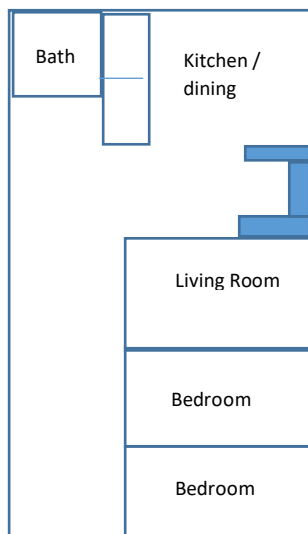
Under each drawing / picture / photo write the person's name and how they are related to you.

Use one colour to circle the lowest price for each item.

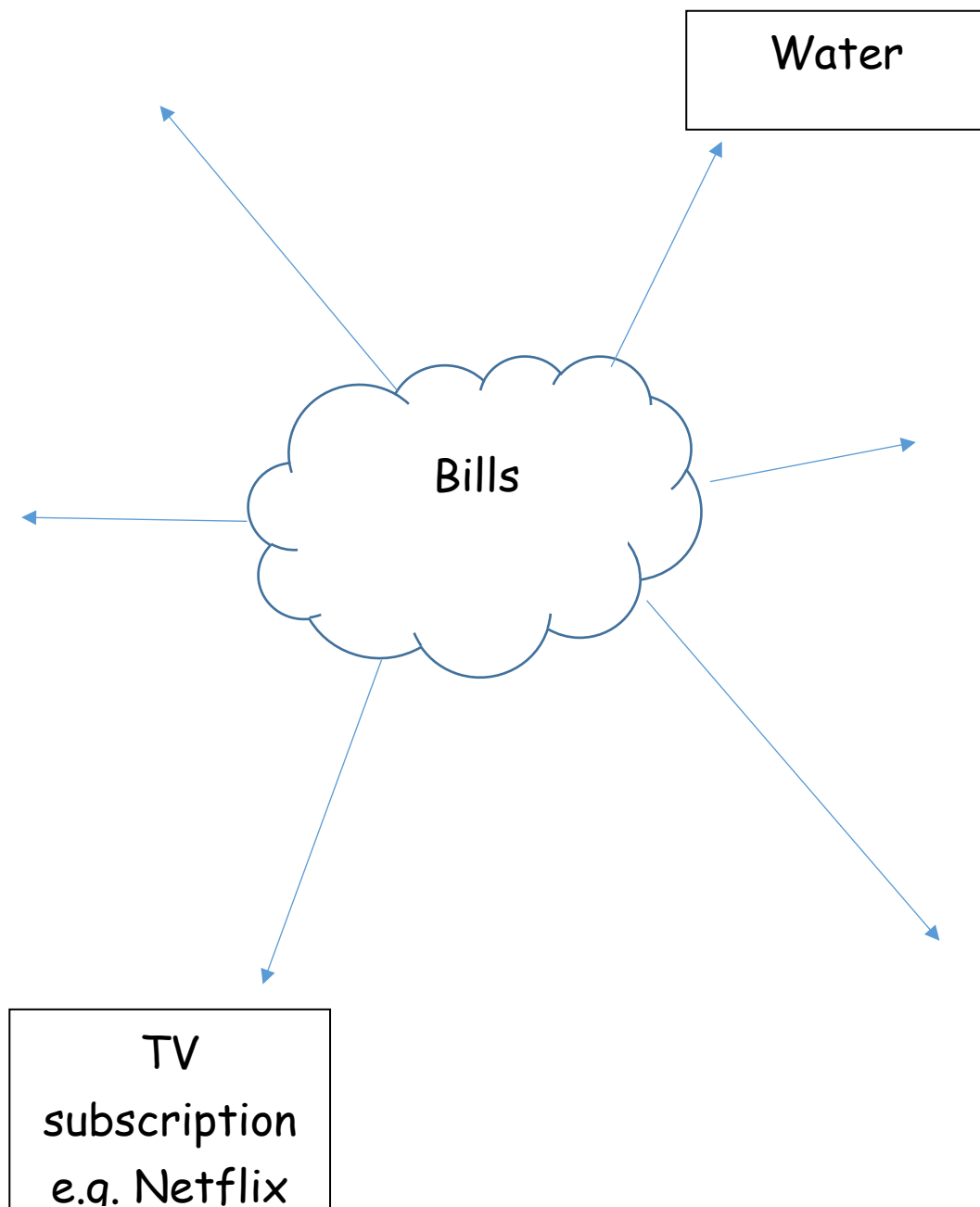
Use the other colour to circle the highest price for each item.
