

Choose from these activities to complete art at home. Upload to Seesaw when you have finished the activity. Do not worry if you do not have art materials at home. You can use Seesaw or Doodle Buddy to create your drawings. You can also use the camera on your iPad. If you do not have access to certain apps just do the activities that you can or make up your own activities to upload to Seesaw.

Colours Everywhere

Look around your house and in your backyard for colourful objects. (flowers, leaves, fruit, toys, fabric) Photograph at least 6-8 colourful objects. You could also search for images on the internet. You can choose one colour or a rainbow of colours. Use the PicCollage app to arrange your photos in a grid. Add a heading, for example "Colours Everywhere".

Photograph- Finding Patterns

Find objects that show patterns. Get up close and take a picture of the objects. For example a leaf, flower, paving, fencing or fabric. You can also search on the internet for images showing patterns. (e.g. animal fur, scales) Create a grid in PicCollage & arrange your images. *Upload your PicCollage to Seesaw.

My example – Patterns at Home



Make a picture with natural or found objects.

Gather natural materials from your garden or use materials from inside your home. Create an image. It could be animal or human. Be creative with your designs! *Photograph & upload to Seesaw or use Tromaramix app to animate your face or creature.



Observational Drawing

Choose something in your house or backyard. For example a piece of fruit, leaf or even a shoe. Look carefully at the object and draw what you see. Remember to let your eyes stay on the object and try not to look down at your paper. Follow the shape of your object with your eyes when drawing. Add details after you have created your outlines. *Upload to Seesaw



Imaginative Drawing

Use the Doodle Buddy drawing app or your own pencils to create a drawing from your imagination. It can have imaginary creatures such as dragons, comic heroes or cartoon characters. You can create your own story in this drawing. *Upload to Seesaw. Make a comment or use the microphone to talk about your drawing.



Lines & Shapes

Create your own Zentangle patterns. Use a white sheet of paper. Fold it in half and keep folding in half to create a grid. Rule down the folded lines. Use a dark pencil or black marker to create different Zentangle patterns for each section. Colour your patterns. This can be an ongoing project. Put some quiet relaxing music on and enjoy.
